## Day-by-Day Itinerary



**May 6: Arrival in Lyon – Welcome to the Heart of Gastronomy**  
Arrive in Lyon and transfer to your charming accommodations at Globe et Cecil. After settling in, enjoy an afternoon walking tour through the city, sampling local charcuterie and wines. **May 7: Exploring Lyon's Heritage and Silk Industry**

Lunch at La Mere Brazier\*\*. After lunch, head to a silk factory and witness the intricate craftsmanship of silk scarves and ties. The evening is yours to explore Lyon's vibrant neighborhoods.

**May 8: A Roman Journey & Scenic Vineyards**  
Head outside Lyon to explore the Musée et Sites Gallo-Romains of Saint-Romain-en-Gal, where you'll step back in time to visit Roman ruins. Lunch at Chez Point-La Pyramide\*\*. After lunch, enjoy a wine tasting and travel through the picturesque vineyards of Cote-Rôtie and Condrieu on your way back to Lyon. Enjoy a free evening in the city.

**May 9: Food Culture in Lyon's Legendary Market**  
Spend the morning at Les Halles de Lyon Paul Bocuse, a world-class food market showcasing the finest French delicacies. Then, explore the historical Traboules—hidden passageways used by silk workers. The day concludes with a delightful dinner at a local restaurant.

**May 10: A Day in Annecy and Chartreuse Liqueur**  
Travel to the beautiful lakeside town of Annecy. Stroll through its charming streets before enjoying a typical Alpine lunch. Afterward, head to the Caves de la Chartreuse for a tasting of the famous Chartreuse liqueur. Return to Lyon for dinner at a local restaurant.

### May 13: Beaujolais Vineyards and Wine Exploration
